

# SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- ⚠ Everyone moving within the industrial area must exercise great caution.
- ⚠ Always yield to vehicles on your right at intersections.
- ⚠ Be aware of other vehicles inside the area; ensure eye contact.
- ⚠ You will be directed to a place for loading or unloading by one of our staff.
- ⚠ Passengers/helpers should not leave the vehicle inside the area.
- ⚠ All movement under suspended loads is strictly prohibited.
- ⚠ All loads must be properly secured according to regulations. Deviations will be notified. Forklift/wheel loader drivers have the right and requirement to interrupt loading/unloading if deviations from these requirements occur.



## Loading and unloading of trucks/semi-trailers

Always follow the instructions of the loading/unloading crew.  
Ensure that the handbrake is engaged, the engine is turned off, and never leave the vehicle unattended.



## GREEN ZONE

For your own safety, we recommend that you stay in the green zone during loading and unloading. Here you have the best overview of what is happening, and the crew can also keep track of your whereabouts.

## YELLOW ZONE

Make sure to have spoken/greeted the crew before entering the yellow zone. Do not stay in the yellow zone while loading/unloading is taking place.

Maintain continuous eye contact with the crew while in the yellow zone; never turn your back.
